

BRIDAL SHOE DYEING

Please note the shoes and or bag are not colourfast.

We recommend the application of a waterproof protector such as 3 x 3 Protector available in store or scotch guard, before wearing, to **help prevent** the colour running if worn in the rain or damp conditions.

Excess moisture may cause the dye to pass through onto the foot. Unfortunately excessive perspiration of the hands and feet may cause similar problems in which case it may be prudent to use an Anti-stain shoe care product sprayed on to the inside of the shoes this product is not suitable for bags.

Your dyed shoes have been colour matched for a **natural daylight**. Due to effects of ultra-violet light the colour may vary if viewed indoors or under artificial light. Off-white or ivory shoes provide the best colour match. Trims, bindings, lace and seam edges may also vary slightly from the main shoe fabric- absorbing more or less of the dye.

To ensure the consistency, all shoes for one wedding party must be dyed at the same time otherwise the colour may vary.

Scuffing or stains to worn shoes cannot be guaranteed to be covered completely, however the darker the dye the better the results.

Shoes or bags that have previously been waterproofed cannot be dyed successfully.
